#### Firebarn Museum

#### The Firebarn Museum

When I arrive at the Museum, I will see this:



I will walk through the doors to meet the front desk person. That person will tell us about the Museum and answer any questions we have.

Inside I will see a horse. The horse is not real so I can get close, but I will stay behind the rope.

If I need a calming place to go while I visit the Firebarn. I can go to the chill out zone on the first floor in the back hallway.\*





Here I can lay on a crash pad, play with fidget toys, and chill.\*

\*Please note the Chill Out Zone is only available during the ASD Sensory Saturday event.

There is a red carriage that the horses pulled a long time ago to help fight fires.



The carriage is behind a rope so I should look, but not touch.

In the back of the room I will see another horse next to a small open room.



I can learn about the animals that helped the Fire Fighters by reading or having an adult read the signs to me.

There is a large Fire truck on the first floor. I can get up close to the Fire Truck and use gentle touch.



When I am done looking at the first floor I can walk up the stairs to the second floor.



There will be more fire fighting objects for me to look at.

\*If it is a ASD Sensory Saturday there will be a craft on the second floor.\*

If I need to use the restroom it is on this floor at the back of the room.



Upstairs I can see where the Firemen slept.




There is a button I can press to listen to a story about how the fireman lived. It is loud so I should ask for help before I press the button.

I can look at the uniforms and tools the Firemen used to fight fires and protect themselves.




When I am done looking around I can head back down the stairs to the first floor.
