



**Supplies:**

- Tissue
- A straw
- Wooden skewer
- Glue
- Tape
- Scissors
- A black marker
- Green construction paper



**Step 1:** Crafting the caterpillar (A pipe cleaner can also be used; in that case you can skip this step!)

Unfold the tissue and cut away  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the sheet

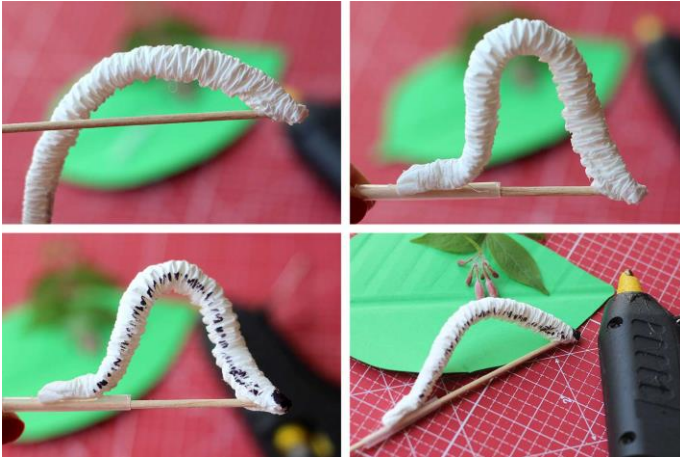
Take the remaining  $\frac{3}{4}$  and wrap around the straw – use glue to make sure it sticks

Once the tissue dries into shape, decorate with markers and remove from around the straw



**Step 2:** Create a leaf

Cut a leaf shape out of the green construction paper and use markers to draw lines on the leaf



**Step 3: Attach caterpillar to the leaf**

Cut a small piece (about 2 inches) of straw and glue/tape one end of the caterpillar to the straw

Thread the skewer through the straw (make sure the skewer can be grabbed on either side of the straw) and glue/tape the other end of the caterpillar to the skewer

Glue/tape the straw to the leaf



**Step 4: You're done!**

Grab the non-caterpillar end of the skewer and move it back and forth through the straw. Your caterpillar will move too!
