QUILTS

PRE K-2ND GRADE

Learn about the history of pioneers in Michigan and why quilting was an important part of everyday life. Participants will design their own quilt square pattern and take home a paper craft version of their design.

FOSSILS OF MICHIGAN

3RD-6TH GRADE

The fossils we find in Michigan provide us with an abundance of information about Michigan's past. Children will examine fossils to learn about different eras, extinction events, and how a changing climate can affect living things. This program also includes an Ice Age predator and prey group game.

STEM MAGNETS

2ND-6TH GRADE

Keep kids engaged in STEM during the summer with this magnet program. Participants will learn about the origin and properties of magnets, how we use magnets every day, and complete a STEM magnet challenge.

MICHIGAN'S FIRST PEOPLE

2ND-6TH GRADE

Go back in time with an overview of pre-contact Native American culture and how the tribes survived within the environment of Michigan. Children will have an opportunity to examine artifacts, furs, and compare life today to life then.
